





Launched in 2014, the Colonial Classic Horse show is a resounding success, drawing more than 420 exhibitors from 20+ local horse show series from six Mid-Atlantic States. Held at Harrisbury Farm Show Complex 8/30-9/1, 2019

To qualify, a rider must be a member of a participating local horse show series. Riders - through their respective horse show series - accumulate points in their division or divisions beginning January 1, 2021 through August 14, 2021.

Brookside's April, May, June, and July shows fall within the qualifying period. The top three riders from each division will be selected by their horse show series to show at the Colonial Classic.
