Rules and Regulations

- ❖ Classes and divisions that are NJHSA, NJPHA, PEL, Colonial Classic, and M&S recognized will be run according to the rules of those organizations.
- ❖ ALL exhibitors must wear USEF approved protective headgear when mounted.
- ❖ The committee, Brookside Show Stable management and staff, and Hidden Hills Farm will NOT be held responsible for any accident, loss, damage, or injury (including death) occurring at the show.
- ❖ Management reserves the right to change, alter, combine, cancel, or add classes, dates, and personnel.
- ❖ All entry forms are to be completely filled out, signed, and presented (email, online, or in person) to the secretary along with full payment before numbers will be assigned. No one will be allowed to show without a number.
- ❖ Everyone agrees to follow the parking official's instructions.
- ❖ Show Office opens at 7am.
- ❖ Entry fees are \$25 unless stated otherwise.
- ❖ Circuit points are calculated 10-6-4-2-1-.5. Riders can earn extra points at our two designated Double Point shows. Points and standings will be updated online after each show.
- ❖ Leadline riders will receive a Circuit Achievement Award. Leadline riders who participate in a minimum 3 shows will be presented a special award at our Series Finale.
- ❖ No Post Entry Fee
- ❖ No Circuit Fees for the Brookside Show Series Circuit Awards
- ❖ No schooling fees, but anyone riding in our schooling areas or schooling during the schooling break NOT planning to compete must still have a number and pay the Office/EMT fee.
- ❖ Must compete in at least 3 shows to be eligible for BSS Circuit Awards
- ❖ Office/EMT fee of \$15 will be applied to all entries
- ❖ Show Phone 908-334-1569
- ❖ Entries accepted online at horseshowing.com
- ❖ New is the Pre Entry Raffles. Entries made by the Wednesday before each show automatically are entered in our raffle. Winners will be announced on our social media Thursday Morning. Winners can pick up their Dover Basket when they collect their back numbers from the secretary! *Sponsored by Dover Saddlery in Branchburg.*
- ❖ A negative coggins with in one year of the show date and a signed Bio security form **must** be presented to the Secretary for all horses on the show grounds, even if not participating in the show.
- ❖ Brookside Show Series follows current local COVID 19 Protocols. Mandatory masks on unless riding. Social distancing must be maintained. Please limit spectators. No extended families. Estimated times of go will be posts on horseshowing.com. P
- ❖ All dogs must be on a leash at all times. No exceptions. Unruly or disruptive dogs will be asked to leave.
- ❖ **A \$10 food truck voucher will be given to any trainer who brings 2 of more students to that show.**
- ❖ It is a condition to enter the show grounds that these rules, regulations, and procedures be read, understood, and accepted. Management reserves the right to decline any entry deemed not in the best interest of the horse show or the horse show community.
- ❖ Any check returned will be charged a \$100 processing fee.
- ❖ Entries must be paid in cash or check. No credit cards will be accepted at the horse show.

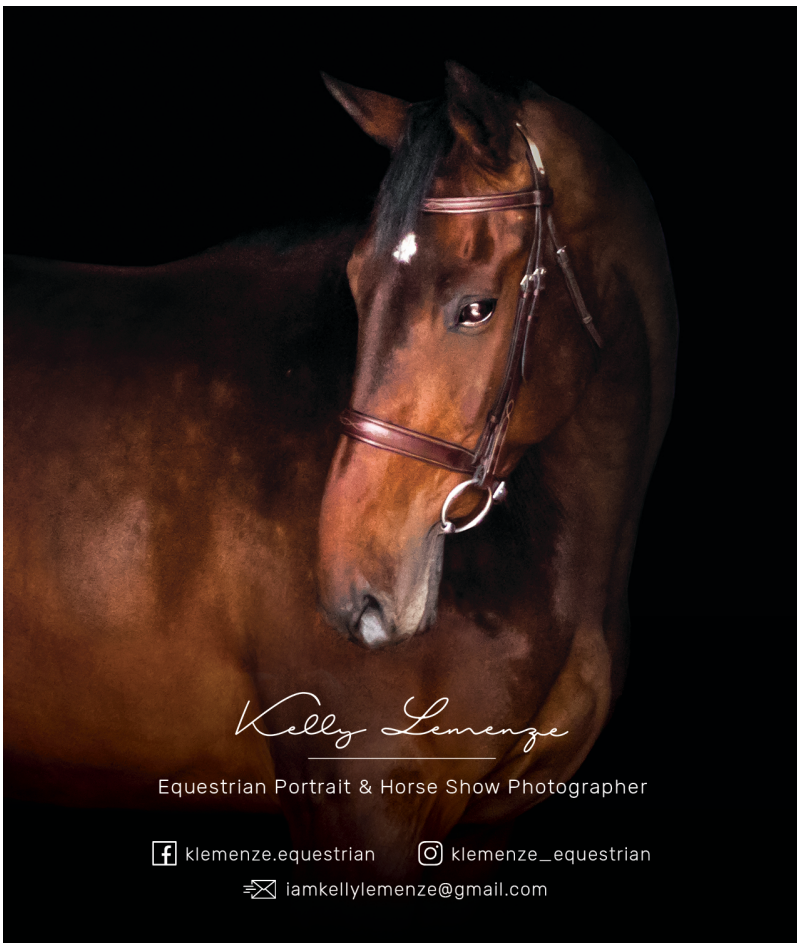

The Colonial Classic Horse Show is a local champions' finals for local exhibitors. Launched in 2014, the Colonial Classic Horse show is a resounding success, drawing more than 420 exhibitors from 20+ local horse show series from six Mid-Atlantic States. Held at Harrisbury Farm Show Complex 8/30-9/1, 2019

To qualify, a rider must be a member of a participating local horse show series. Riders - through their respective horse show series - accumulate points in their division or divisions beginning January 1, 2021 through August 14, 2021. Brookside's April, May, June, and July shows fall within the qualifying period. The top three riders from each division will be selected by their horse show series to show at the Colonial Classic.

It is up to each rider to be familiar with the specs of their respective division at the Colonial Classic horse show. Specs for divisions at Brookside Show Series do not always match up exactly with the corresponding division at the Colonial Classic. Please make sure you meet all requirements for the final.
