RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ❖ Classes and divisions that are NJHSA, NJPHA, PEL, Colonial Classic, USHJA Outreach, and M&S recognized will be run according to the rules of those organizations.
 - ❖ All classes count for USHJA Outreach points except Leadline, Crossrail Jumpers, and Leapfrog Jumpers.
 - ❖ ALL exhibitors must wear USEF approved protective headgear when mounted.
 - ❖ The committee, Brookside Show Stable management, Rebelle Hill Farm, and staff will NOT be held responsible for any accident, loss, damage, or injury (including death) occurring at the show.
 - ❖ Management reserves the right to change, alter, combine, cancel, or add classes, dates, and personnel.
 - ❖ All entry forms are to be completely filled out, signed, and presented (email, online, or in person) to the secretary along with full payment before numbers will be assigned. No one will be allowed to show or school without a number.
 - ❖ Everyone agrees to follow the parking official's instructions.
 - ❖ Show Office opens at 7am.
 - ❖ Entry fees are \$25 unless stated otherwise.
 - ❖ No Membership Fees for the Brookside Show Series Circuit Awards. Riders and/or horses must be members of the other organizations to have their points recognized in those associations.
 - ❖ No schooling fees for competing rides, but anyone riding in our schooling areas or schooling during the schooling break NOT planning to compete must still have a number, pay the Office/EMT fee, and be charged a \$50 non competitor fee.
 - ❖ Must compete in your division at least 3 shows to be eligible for BSS Circuit Awards
 - ❖ Office/EMT fee of \$25 and USHJA Outreach fee of \$3 will be applied to all entries.
 - ❖ Anyone who fails to check out by the end of the show will be charged a \$50 closeout fee.
 - ❖ Any check returned will be charged a \$100 processing fee.
 - ❖ Entries must be paid in **cash or check only**. No Credit Card, Zelle, PayPal, or Venmo will be accepted at the horse show.
 - ❖ Pre-Entries accepted online at horseshowing.com or completed entries emailed to info@brooksideshowstable.com until Friday at 9pm the night before the show.
 - ❖ Entries received in person to the secretary at the horse show or after 9pm on Friday will be charged a \$20 Post Entry fee.
 - ❖ Pre-Entry Raffles. Entries made by the Wednesday before each show automatically are entered in our raffle. Winners will be announced on our social media Thursday Morning. Winners can pick up their Dover Gift Card when they collect their back numbers from the secretary! *Sponsored by Dover Saddlery in Branchburg.*
 - ❖ A negative coggins within one year of the show date **must** be presented to the Secretary for all horses on the show grounds, even if not participating in the show.
 - ❖ All dogs must be on a leash. No exceptions.
 - ❖ It is a condition to enter the show grounds that these rules, regulations, and procedures be read, understood, and accepted. Management reserves the right to decline any entry deemed not in the best interest of the horse show or the horse show community.

Must be entered and pay for one other class at the horse show aside from the Derby to be eligible. Derbies will run during the respective heights. Ribbons to 6th at the end of each section.
